3. What other things can be blown out?

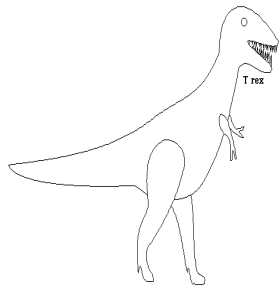
2. Make a picture of what you have seen at the “*bufones*”.
